The purpose of this program is to encourage students to be actively involved in their school and community. Students who go above and beyond classroom expectations and contribute to our community will be recognized.

Why would I want to participate?

- Opportunity to make a difference in the community
- Letters of recommendation & community experience for resume
- \$1,000.00 scholarship to a Highland student. (Funding reviewed annually.)
- Personal recognition at Senior Awards Night: All participants will receive certificates, along with Service Seals for graduation announcements.
- Personal recognition at graduation: All participants wear a purple cord.

What do I need to do? (150 total service hours)

- Complete 150 hours of service throughout grades 8-12.
- Fill out a Service Completion Form for each service project (with exception of senior project) and turn it in to Carolyn Ebert in room E-103.
- 25-75 hours must be the Senior Service-Learning Project and Journal. Senior projects may begin the summer after the Jr. year. **Seniors must see Carolyn Ebert for project pre-approval and a *Service-Learning Journal*.**

Guidelines

- A maximum of 75 hours with the same agency.
- Service hours must be outside of class time and not for your immediate family.
- Service completed with church groups (outside of regular meeting time) is acceptable.

What do I need to do to be eligible for the scholarship?

- Complete the Journal and Service Completion Forms by May 1st of the senior year.

Can I earn the award without the Senior Project and Journal?

- Students who complete 150 hours of service and submit Service Completion Forms for each service project may earn the award, but will NOT be eligible for the scholarship.
