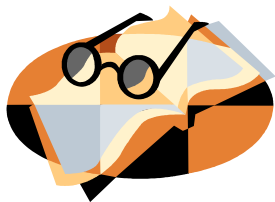

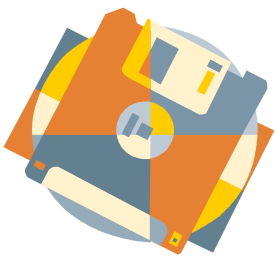

This is an Internet resource that your student can access at school, at the local public library or at home from a computer with Internet access.

EBSCO—General reference and journals, magazines and newspapers resources.

EMedia—Search, preview, and download educational videos and supporting media.

Utah Digital Newspapers—Search old newspapers from various Utah communities.

SIRS Knowledge Source—General reference for high school and college researchers.
