Based on State PTA rules and guidelines, these works of art may be submitted for state and national level awards and recognition opportunities.

Of the national-level submissions, over 200 student Reflections participants will receive the following awards from National PTA:

- Merit Award: Bronze Medal; Certificate of Merit; Work featured in the traveling exhibition
- Award of Excellence: \$200 Young Artist Scholarship; Silver Medal; Certificate of Excellence; Work featured in the traveling exhibition
- Outstanding Interpretation Award: \$800 Young Artist Scholarship; Gold Medal; Certificate of Outstanding Interpretation; Work featured in the traveling exhibition; \$200 Prize for Local PTA Unit

Highland High will be hosting a **SLCC Concurrent Enrollment Information Session** on **Monday, November 9 at 6:30PM** via **Zoom**. Concurrent Enrollment is a dual enrollment process where high school students can earn high school and college credit simultaneously. These are rigorous college classes that require students to attend, to work hard and to submit assignments on time. While in high school, these college courses are offered at a reduced rate of approximately \$15/class. These same class will cost students hundreds of dollars once they graduate from college.
