Dear Teacher, Parents, and Students:

I am happy to announce a free math tutoring service that is available to Salt Lake City School District high school students taking Secondary Math I or Secondary Math II. Undergraduate math majors and minors at the University of Utah have volunteered their time to provide math support to the community. Homework support will be provided on **Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:00-4:00** via Zoom, through a link embedded in students' Canvas learning management system.

Math I and II students have been invited to join an optional Canvas course called **Mon/Wed 3:00-4:00 Math Help** through their school district email. **Students who wish to access the service will need to accept the Canvas course invitation.** Embedded in the course is a link to Zoom meetings through which students can access tutors, who will rotate between students throughout the hour. This is **not** a regular class, attendance will not be taken, and there are no grades/credit associated with it. Students cannot receive extra credit nor regular course credit for their time. The Canvas course is not attended to outside of the tutoring hours, so the Canvas messaging environment will not be utilized.

School district certified employees and university instructors/tutors are working collaboratively to facilitate this resource. Students will be placed in their own breakout room and tutors will work with them individually or in small groups. We hope you will find this opportunity useful and enriching.
